

LIBRARY DIRECTOR

The position requires a person knowledgeable in current library technologies, personnel administration, budget management, innovative public library practices and community relations.

The Boone-Madison Public Library is a single-county public library system serving approximately 25,000 residents of Boone County, West Virginia, in the Southern West Virginia coalfields. The library is headquartered in Madison, the county seat, and has branches in Coal River, Whitesville, and Wharton. The library participates in the Mountain Library Network (<http://mtlibrary.mln.lib.wv.us/>), a consortia sharing automation and other services with approximately 37 other public, school and academic libraries in the region. Although a small library system, the system prides itself on quality customer and community service. Madison, the county seat of Boone County is a short 35 minute drive from Charleston, the state capital and the state's largest city, and is within a day's drive of many of the nation's largest metropolitan areas.

Applicants must have a MLS/MLIS degree from an ALA accredited program. Two years of library experience is preferred. Salary is negotiable from \$35,000 annually, and benefits are provided including participation in the West Virginia Public Employees Retirement System, West Virginia Public Employees Insurance Agency health insurance, sick leave and vacation leave, and other benefits.
