

Morgantown Public Library System Director

The Board of Trustees of the Morgantown Public Library System is seeking an energetic and innovative library director to lead the libraries in the provision of outstanding services and programs for our thriving community. The successful candidate will engage with community leaders and other stakeholders to build strong relationships. The director will be responsible for all day-to-day operations of the libraries, for developing and managing budgets, for collaborative planning and assessment of services, and for developing and evaluating library staff. The position requires strong financial and personnel management skills, as well as demonstrated success in strategic planning, technology management, and community relations.

Minimum qualifications include a Master's Degree from an American Library Association accredited school. Six years of professional library experience, with at least 3 years of administrative experience are required.

The Morgantown Public Library System includes a main library in Morgantown and 5 branch libraries located throughout Monongalia County, WV. It serves a population of 96,189. In 2016, 28,413 current cardholders checked out more than 250,000 items. The library has an operating budget of \$1.6 million dollars and a staff of 24 full-time equivalent employees.
