

### **XML: A Functional Primer (Live Online)**

This class introduces the basics of markup languages, from SGML through XML. IT then introduces the fundamentals of XML, DTD creation and Extensible Styling Language (XSL).

XML, the Extensible Markup Language, has become the Lingua Franca of the new age of data exchange languages. From everything from RSS to SOAP, XHTML to Atom, and from TEI to EAD, XML permeates our data.
