What is the Foundation Center?

The **Foundation Center** is a non-profit 501(c)(3) that collects information on grants and grant making foundations across the globe.

Their mission is to distribute this information to non-profits and individuals seeking funding.

What are the Cooperating Collections?

The **Foundation Center Cooperating Collections** are libraries located throughout the United States that make this information available to organizations and individuals in their community.

The **West Virginia Cooperating Collections** have print and electronic materials available on topics such as:

- Starting your own non-profit.
- How to write a grant.
- How to find funders.
- Grant seeking for individuals.
- Proposal budgeting basics.
